

RBHS Student Dress Code (2023-2024)

We strive to give students an opportunity for choice and creative expression within the dress code. However, school dress and grooming must be modest and decent. In matters of opinion, the judgment of administration will prevail. Students out of dress code will be subject to disciplinary consequences.

Shirts

- Writing and pictures must be appropriate (must not depict drug, alcohol, tobacco, sex, gangs, etc.)
- Size appropriate (**no undersized shirts or crop tops/shirts must be able to be tucked in**)
- No spaghetti straps or tank tops.
- Must be modest (no sheer tops, no cleavage or bare midriff, etc.)

Pants or Shorts

- Shorts may be worn, but they must touch at least the mid-thigh including athletic shorts. Shorts must have a hem (no cut-offs).
- Jeggings, spandex, stretch pants, leggings, yoga pants cannot be see-through and a top must cover your bottom.
- No pajama pants
- No pants with holes, rips, or tears that expose visible skin above the knee.
- Skirts and dresses can be worn and need to be knee length.
- No sagging (pants must be worn at waist - no underclothing may show.)

Headwear

- No hats, hoods, bandanas, or head coverings (except for religious purposes).

Outerwear

- If outerwear is removed, then what is underneath must meet dress code.
- Blankets may not be worn as outerwear and must be left at home or placed in a backpack upon entering the building.

Footwear

- Shoes must have outdoor sole (no house shoes)

Face Masks

- Writing and pictures must be appropriate (must not depict drug, alcohol, tobacco, sex, gangs, etc.)
