RBHS Tardy Policy

Students who arrive at school after the beginning of the student school day (7:20) will be marked tardy, as shall students who arrive late to individual classes during the school day.

1st Block

Number of Tardies Consequence

- 1-4 Warning
- 5-6 Lunch Detention (each tardy)
- 7-8 Day School followed by Evening School 2:30-4:30PM (each tardy)
- 9+ ISS for each tardy

$2^{\underline{nd}} - 5^{\underline{th}}$ Blocks

Number of Tardies Consequence

- 1-2 Teacher Warning
- 3 Teacher Assigned Consequence, and Parent Contact
- 4-5 Lunch Detention/No Pass list
- 6-8 Day School followed by Evening School 2:30-4:30PM (each tardy)
- 9+ ISS for each tardy

Notes:

- Students are considered tardy to their first block if they are not in class at 7:20 AM. Students riding buses will be excused if the bus is late. Car riders will only be excused in the event of an exceptional circumstance (i.e. car wreck).
- Tardies are recorded per block. Administration reserves the ability to assess additional consequences for habitual offenders.
- Teachers will record tardies daily and will refer students to administrators when necessary.
- Tardies reset at the end of each quarter.
- If assigned lunch detention, a student must report to lunch detention within 10 minutes of the start of the lunch period. Students will not be permitted to leave lunch detention until the conclusion of the lunch period.
- If assigned Evening School, a student must report to Evening School by 2:30PM. Students will be dismissed at 4:30PM to meet their ride home or drive if they have their own transportation.
